REVISED PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 72 of the Public Procurement Act, Cap 410, the Authority is mandated to debar firms or individuals from participating in public procurement and disposal of public assets by tender on specified grounds and to inform Procuring Entities (PEs) and the general public accordingly. In line with the above-cited provision, the **GENERAL PUBLIC** is hereby informed that the Authority has debarred three (3) companies/firms. The key information on companies/firms debarred from participating in public procurement, and the disposal of public assets by tender, is provided under **Table A** below. Generally, these companies/firms have been debarred for various grounds and durations in Two (2) different categories as follows:

1. *Category One*: Firm (s) debarred for a **period of One (1) year**, effective from **22rd April 2026**, on the Grounds of Fraud (forgery);
2. *Category Two*: Firm debarred for a **period of one (6) Months**, effective from **22rd April 2026**, on the grounds of Failure to Sign a Procurement Contract.

THEREFORE, following issuance of the debarment decision/order, PEs and the general public are hereby **NOTIFIED** that, by virtue of regulation 104(3) of the Public Procurement Regulations, 2024, all persons who at the time of debarment were involved in the management of affairs of the debarred firms/companies as directors, partners, agents or officers are also not allowed to participate in public procurement or disposal of public assets by tender for the same periods in which a firm(s) is debarred. Also, pursuant to section 72(8) of Cap 410, such directors, partners, agents or officers are not allowed to incorporate any company or entity for purposes of supplies, civil works, consultancy and non-consultancy services for the duration of debarment. The **GENERAL PUBLIC** is further informed that M/s Sichuan Road & Bridge (Group) Corporation Limited has been **cleared from debarment** after a decision by the Public Procurement Appeals Authority (PPAA) in Appeal No. 35 of 2025-2026, following its debarment for a period of one (1) year on allegations of Failure to Implement a Procurement Contract.
